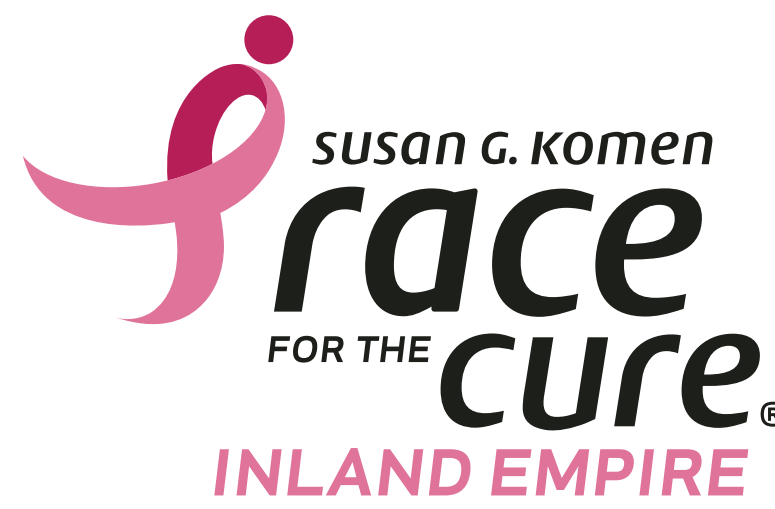

## Affiliate Grant Recipients

Susan G. Komen® Inland Empire was incorporated in 1998 and hosted its inaugural Susan G. Komen Inland Empire Race for the Cure® in 1999. Komen Inland Empire’s service area covers more than 27,000 square miles serving a population of over 4.3 million residents residing in Riverside County, San Bernardino County and the Coachella Valley.

Each year, 75 percent of our net proceeds are invested in mission programs and grants to local non-profit organizations. Since the Affiliate’s inception in 1998, \$6.2 million has been awarded to local non-profit organizations that provide breast cancer education, diagnostic services, patient navigation and treatment support programs for the uninsured or underinsured residents in the Inland Empire. The remaining 25 percent is directed to the Susan G. Komen® Grants Program to fund ground breaking breast cancer research on a national and international level. The Affiliate has also dedicated more than \$2 million towards breast cancer research programs.
